

Child Assessment Service - Warm Reminders for Attending Assessment

Notice

- Child must attend the assessment
- Child's father/mother and caregiver must attend the assessment
- Please bring along a relative/friend who speaks Cantonese or English if child's parents could only communicate in Putonghua or other dialects, or contact centre staff to arrange interpreter if need
- Please bring along a sign language interpreter if child's parent has hearing impairment who can only communicate through sign language
- If child/parent/companion is feeling unwell (e.g. cold/fever/rash etc.), they should not attend the assessment and should contact centre staff for further arrangements as soon as possible
- If child is on medication, he/she may take the medication as usual on the day of assessment. Parents can bring along the medication for our reference

Please bring along the following items when attending the assessment

1. Hong Kong Birth Certificate/Hong Kong Identity Card (Original copy)
2. Centre Follow-up card
3. Document with medical history and follow-up slip of other specialist clinics (if applicable)
4. Child Health Record issued by Maternal and Child Health Centre
5. All health records and assessment reports (e.g. assessment reports issued by Psychologists or Therapists, hearing test reports, vision test reports, etc.)
6. For child has already admitted to school, please bring:
 - Chinese, English and Mathematics homework (primary student should also bring his/her homework, test papers, compositions and dictation books of different subjects)
 - Student Handbook
 - Transcripts of recent examinations
 - Progress reports, assessment reports and training progress reports (if applicable)
7. Child's assistive devices (e.g. hearing aids and new batteries, eye-glasses, vision aids etc.) (if applicable)
8. For child attending assessment by Doctor/Physiotherapist:
 - Child who can walk should wear sportswear and sports shoes (colorfast shoe soles)
 - Child who has physical weakness, please wear (or bring) shorts
 - Please bring along child's rehabilitation equipment (e.g. walking aids/ankle-foot orthosis etc.)
 - Please bring photos or video footages of child's rehabilitation equipment if you cannot bring the equipment to centre
9. For child receiving hearing test (Auditory Brainstem Response - only being notified to take the medicine)
Please do not eat for 4 hours & drink for 2 hours before the assessment
10. Other items necessary (e.g. clothes, snacks, beverage etc.)
11. For child who has special need (e.g. oxygen therapy), please notify our staff during appointment booking
